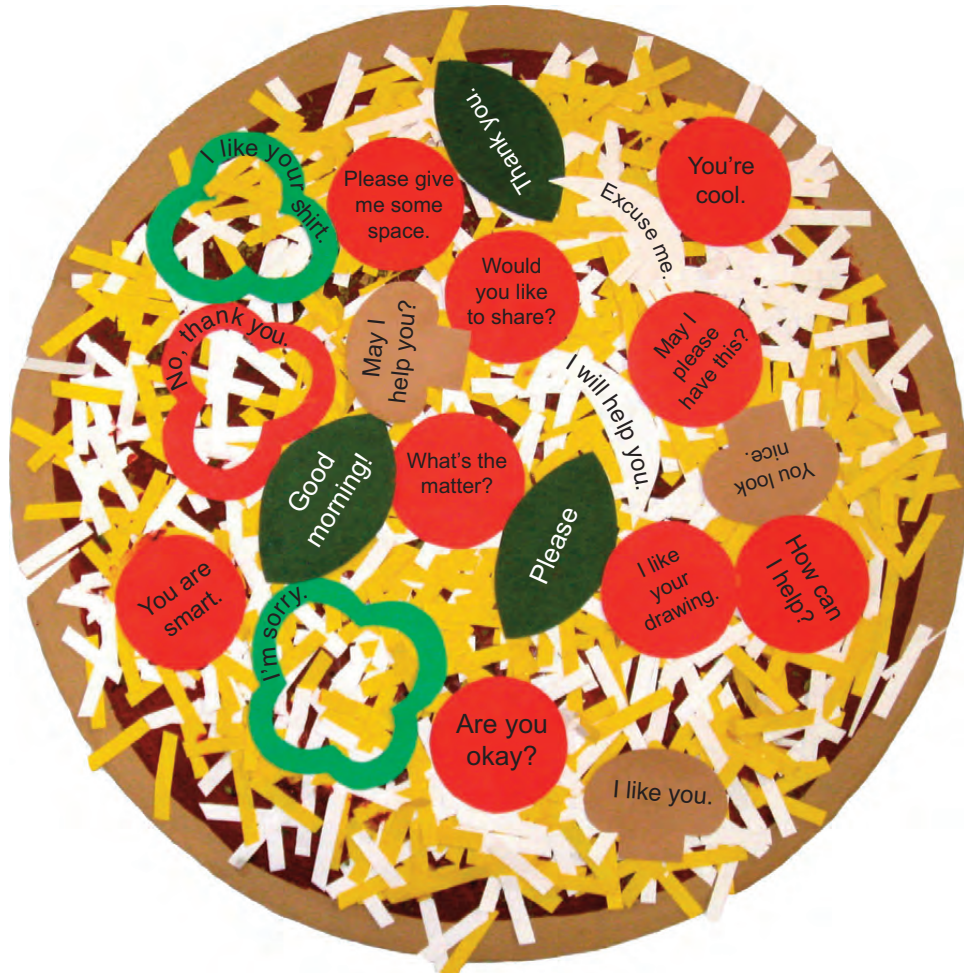


Peace Pizza

About This Book/Song

Cheese, cheese, cheese—

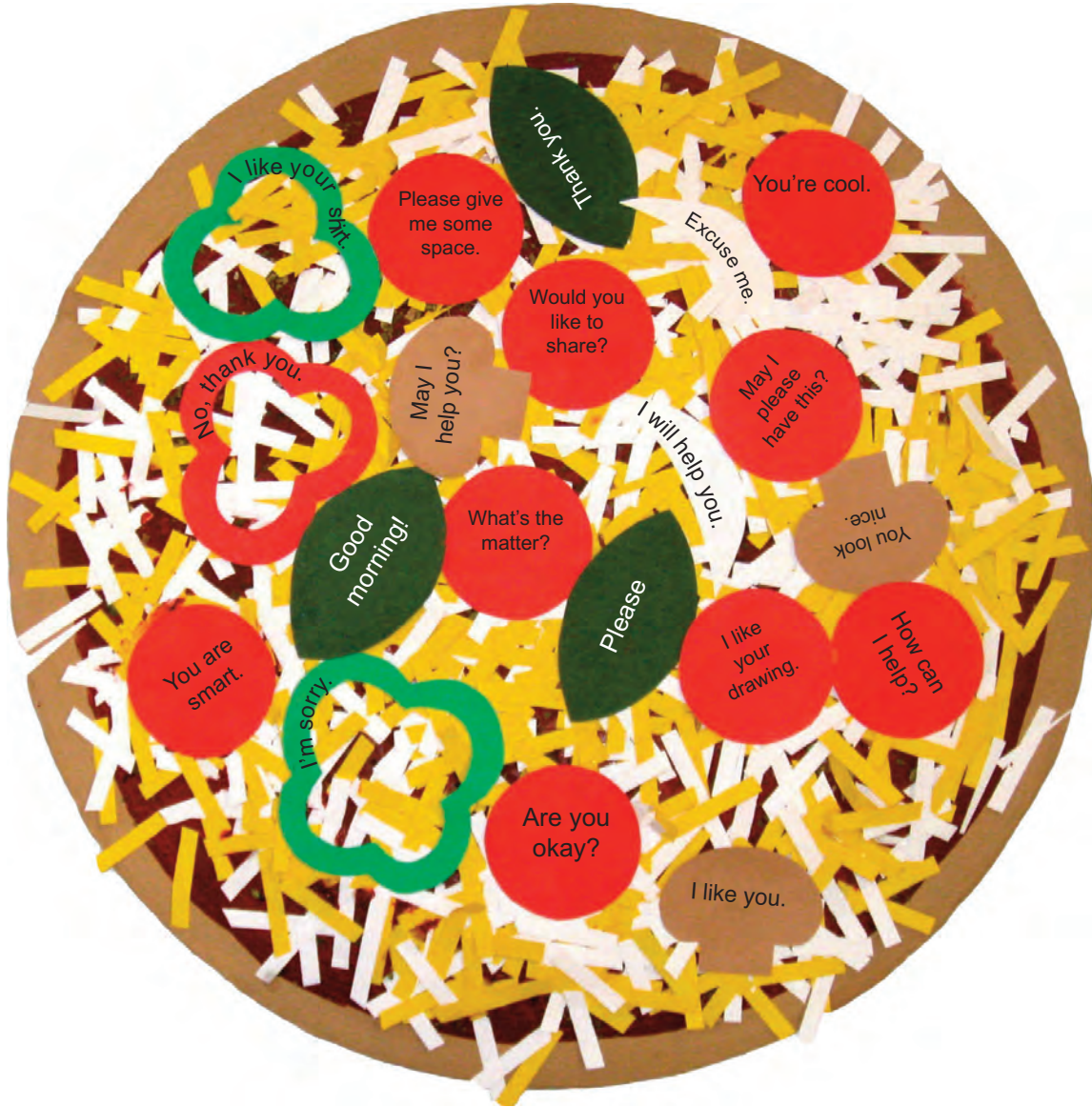
This is step three.
